Plants and flowers: Zamioculcas zamiifolia (ZZ plant), Sansevieria 'Bantel's Sensation', orchids, assorted blooming plants and bromeliads.

Growers/brokers used: Vickery Wholesale Greenhouse.

Containers: ASI containers: EUTC 1530 Black Matte with Chrome Stand, ETHW 481624 Black Matte, EUTC 1836 Black Matte with Chrome Stand, SPH 1512 Earth Sphere White.

Topdressing: Green sheet moss

Other materials: ASI-White Pearl River Rock, light weight

Corporate Green has exclusively maintained this account for the past 28 years without an interruption in service.

In 1985 this beautiful Class A commercial office building, 400,000 square feet, 20 stories was built. Corporate Green, Inc. had been in business six months when the referral call was received. At that time the company only had one employee - the owner. What a great project to help start a business. The original interiorscape design consisted of Pyromedia containers (oil jars and low bowls with seasonal color and cylinder floor planters with foliage.) The seasonal color program changed out 55 pieces of color every 2-5 weeks. We used golf balls to turn large "Fiddle Leaf Fig" plant and prevent damage to the granite floor.

The interior landscape plants and containers were enjoyed by the tenants and ownership for 28 years. Then came the new wave of design...CLEAN SIMPLE LINES AND LEED.
